



Splash Pad Rules

HOURS OF OPERATION

11:00AM - 7:00PM Weekdays • 12:00PM - 6:00PM Weekends

The splash pad may close down at any time for maintenance or weather conditions

- All persons using the splash pad do so at their own risk.
- All children under the age of 18 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times. Supervising adults may not leave the splash pad area.
- Only water is permitted within the splash pad enclosure - no other food, beverages, or glass containers allowed.
- No animals allowed in the splash pad enclosure other than certified service animals.
- The splash pad is a smoke-free zone.
- Proper swim attire is required - swim pants or swim diapers are required for anyone in diapers.
- All persons using the splash pad must follow directions of splash pad staff.
- All park rules apply.
- Band-aids must be removed before using the splash pad.

The following activities are **NOT** permitted:

- Running, rough play, profanity, or climbing on any equipment.
- Outside toys, water balloons, water guns, or recreational equipment.
- Skateboards, skates, rollerblades, scooters, or bicycles.
- Changing of diapers in the splash pad enclosure.
- Soaps, detergents, or shampoos.
- Persons with open wounds, infections, or diseases that may be transmitted by water are not permitted.
