DO YOU NEED HELP STAYING IN YOUR HOME?

ARE YOU EXPERIENCING A FINANCIAL HARDSHIP DUE TO COVID-19?

MICHIGAN HOMEOWNER'S ASSISTANCE FUND (MIHAF)

Was created to assist homeowners experiencing a COVID-19 related hardship.

REQUIREMENTS

- Own and Occupy your home as your Primary Residence
- Have a COVID-Related Hardship including either a:
 - Loss or decrease in Income
 - Material Increase in Expenses
- Income below 150% of Area Media Income
 - \$96,000 for a family of 2 or \$120,000 for a family of 4

You may be eligible to receive up to \$25,000 to pay:

- Property taxes
- Delinquent mortgage/housing expenses, escrow shortages and corporate advances
- Delinquent land contract payments, mobile home consumer loan payments or contracted park lot payments
- Condominium/homeowners association fees
- Homeowners insurances, hazard, flood or mortgage insurance
- Utilities and internet services
