 Local governments must post the current year report on their website or in a public place.  
 The local government must electronically submit the form to its governing body.  
 Local governments must have had an actuarial experience study conducted by the plan actuary for each retirement system at least every 5 years.  
 Local governments must have had a peer actuarial audit conducted by an actuary that is not the plan actuary OR replace the plan actuary at least every 8 years.
